Position announcement - Assistant Professor, Korean Studies

Cornell University, The Department of Asian Studies invites applications for a position in Korean Studies at the rank of assistant professor (tenure track) to begin July 1, 2011. Responsibilities include teaching courses about Korea at undergraduate and graduate levels and advising graduate students in the field. Area of specialization should be Korean humanities with strong emphasis on Korean literature, media studies, or cultural studies with Korean language competence. Candidates must be able to contribute to the teaching curriculum and the research profile of an interdisciplinary department that provides undergraduate and graduate instruction and trains scholars to relate Korean humanities to transnational concerns. Ph.D. required.

To ensure full consideration, candidates should send letter of application, CV, writing sample(s); article(s) and/or dissertation chapter(s), 60-80 pages; syllabi and other materials illustrating successful teaching, and three letters of recommendation by November 1, 2010 to Korean Studies Search Committee, Department of Asian Studies, Cornell University, 350 Rockefeller Hall, Ithaca NY 14853-2502.
