### Professor, Korean language and culture

**Responsibilities:** This is primarily a research position, including supervision of doctoral candidates and teaching at both graduate and under-graduate level. Certain administrative duties also may be included in this position. The main research field is Korean language/linguistics as well as an additional field like e.g. Korean literature, Korean history, Korean religions, Korean art and/or archaeology or Korean anthropology. The list is not exhaustive.

The minimum **qualification** for the appointment as a professor requires documented evidence of both scholarly skill and teaching ability. Applicants have to demonstrate a scholarly record that is considerably superior to the qualitative demands for an associate professor (Swedish 'docent'). Applicants also will be considered with respect to their capability to plan, perform and evaluate teaching, as well as supervision of theses and examination on various levels.

In order to obtain this position, documented evidence of an excellent practical and theoretic mastery of the Korean language is required, as well as scholarly qualification within one or more of the additional fields as indicated above.

**Selection Criteria.** Applicants should present documented evidence of both their research expertise and their teaching ability, relevant to the field of the Korean Language and Culture. Experience of leadership and administrative skill at university level is relevant to this position and also will be considered. The applicants' ability to disseminate research by means of popular science will be considered as well. The candidate that will be chosen will be the one who is considered to possess the most evident capacity to carry out the duties of the position in question, as well as to contribute to the progress and development of the department. Scholarly skill and teaching ability will be evaluated with equal precision.
