The focus and theme of the conference is “**Building Connections and Strengthening Ties through Education**”.

Experience Korea in Tanzania aims at bringing together scholars, researchers and graduate students dealing with various topics on Korea. Please submit your abstract {max.300 words} and biography {max.100 words} by March 25, 2017. Undergraduate students wishing to present papers will be required to submit a recommendation letter from a professor that is familiar with their research.
