The late nineteenth – mid-twentieth century was a turning point for the political, social, cultural, and other systems of the Korean peninsula. At that time, Korea crossed the boundaries of its traditionally formed civilizational limits and started to explore the world outside of Northeast Asia.

The Conference is aiming to shed a light on this dramatic transitional phase of Korean history. Its organizing committee is aiming to provide a platform for in-depth academic and scientific exchanges between specialists majoring in the Northeast Asian region.
